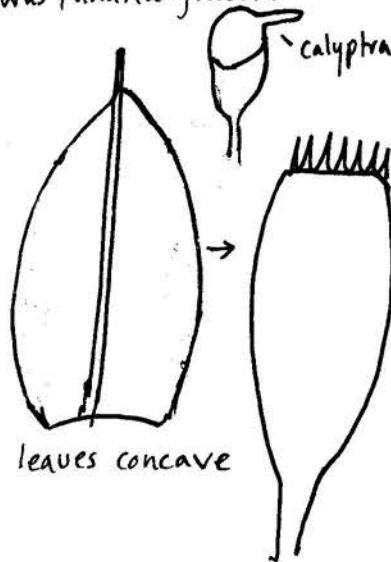

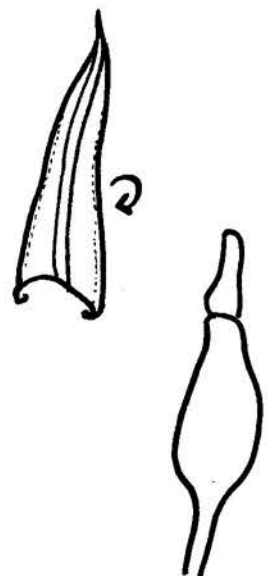

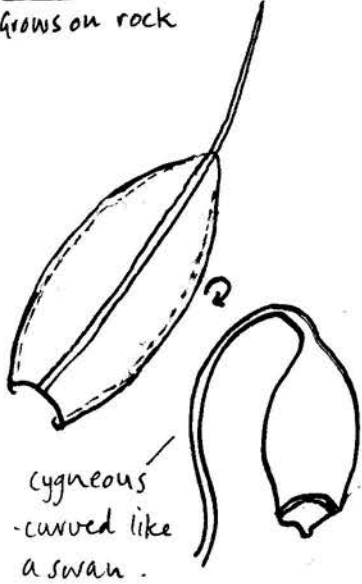

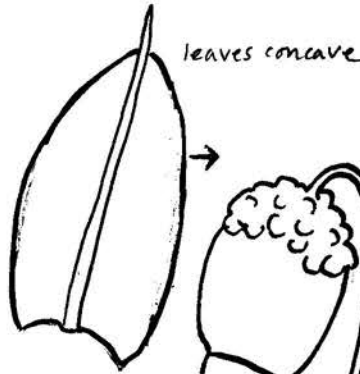

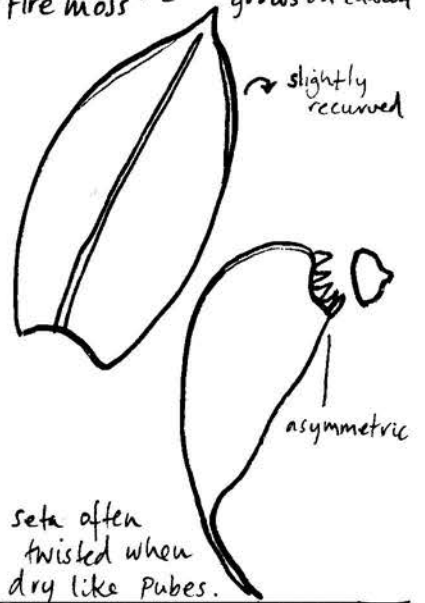


leaves concave

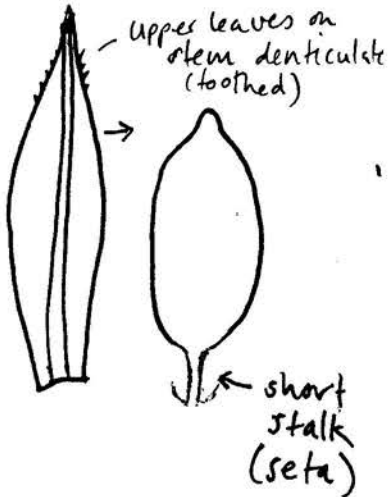


slightly recurved

seta often twisted when dry like Pubes.

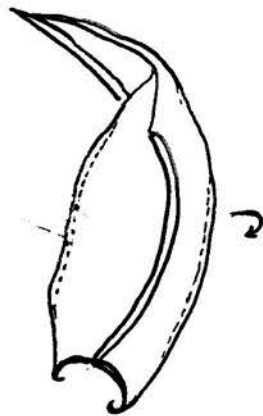
Pleurozium nervosum

short stalk (seta)

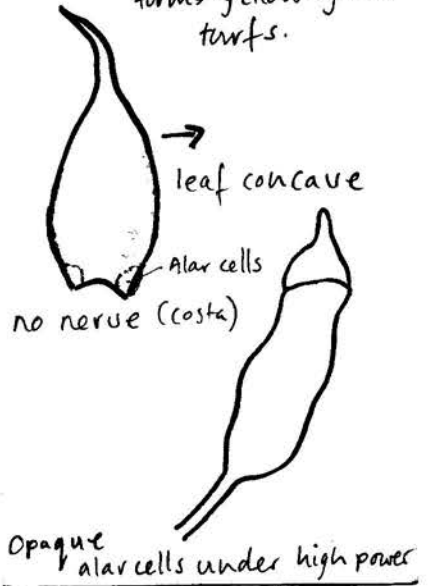
Leptodontium paradoxum

leaf concave

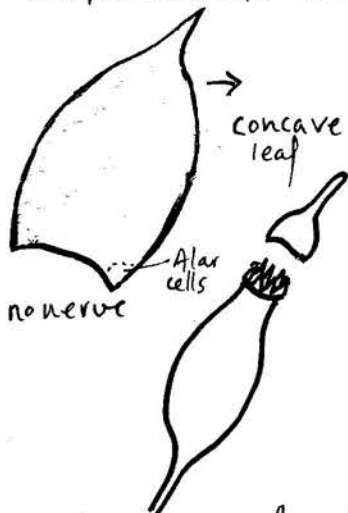
Alar cells

forms bronze-brown turfs like plush retro furnishings.



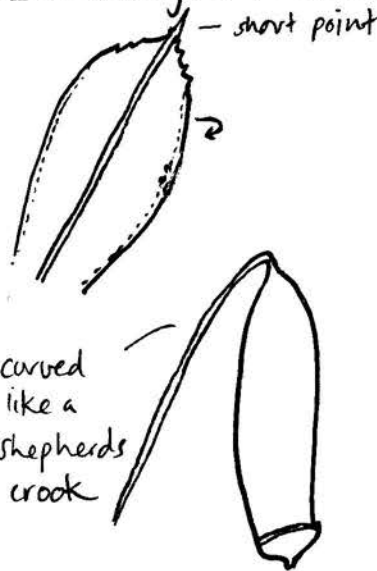

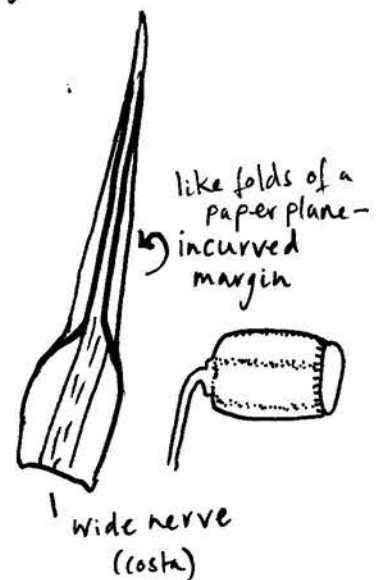

curved like a shepherds crook

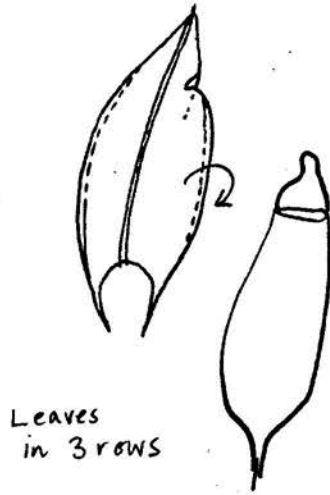
